Unique in the Sonoma County Wine Country is the historic town of Geyserville. It's only here, in all of Wine Country, that fabulous wine tasting rooms bump shoulders with small town charm from a bygone age. Winemakers of world-renown, famous Hollywood names, artists of distinction and Zagat-reviewed chef-owned restaurants are all blended with one-of-a-kind accommodations, shops and wine hospitality rooms to create a vintage blend that is complex, earthy, spicy, sweet and brilliant.

Main Street Geyserville still holds the charm of 100 years ago in its historic buildings. Visitors strolling through town can imagine a dusty street with horse drawn carriages or Model T's parked before the buildings that now house



cutting-edge wineries, restaurants and shops. Accommodations in Geyserville range from the historic Victorian to the contemporary, and one that can be found on a famous guide to the out of the ordinary. But just like everything else in Geyserville, that's not quite the whole story.

Every visitor site of interest in Geyserville is independently owned and not to be found anywhere else in the world! Many of the businesses were started by grandparents or great-grandparents and have been maintained in the family for more than 100 years. With some, the children and grandchildren left Geyserville, did amazing things in other places and returned to live in this bucolic town.
